- 1. Patients of Rural Health Clinics shall have the right to:
 - a. Be treated equally without regard to age, sex, race, religion, or creed
 - B. Receive care that is not determined by the patient's ability to pay;
 - c. Confidentiality of his or her records;
 - d. By informed of all costs and expected payments from other resources;
 - e. Be treated with respect for the patient's dignity, comfort, and privacy;
 - f. Be informed of his or her rights in advance of care being provided;
 - g. Access information in his or her medical record within a reasonable time frame;
 - h. Make decisions regarding his or her care;
 - i. Formulate advance directives and have providers and staff follow those directives;
 - j. Maintain privacy and receive care in a safe setting;
 - k. Be free from physical or verbal abuse or harassment from staff;
- 2. Patients of Rural Health Clinics are responsible for:
 - a. Providing, to the extent possible, information needed by professional staff to provide healthcare services;
 - b. Following instructions and guidelines by healthcare providers.
